Policy and Procedure
COVID-19 Reopening Plan
Outdoor Visitation Policy**

Effective Date: July 27, 2020

Policy:

It is the policy of Harrison House of Chester County to follow the below procedure for outdoor visitation for residents and visitors.

Purpose:

As part of the Reopening Implementation Plan to provide visitation for residents and visitors.

Procedure:

1. Weather permitting, outdoor visitation will take place in pre-determined areas.
 - a. Designated areas include tented space on the back patio and in the grass covered area.
 - b. Weather permitting status is at the discretion of the Executive Director/Designee.
 - c. All visitation areas will be disinfected between each visit.
2. Every resident is limited to two visitors per visit, children are included in this number.
 - a. Adult visitors must be able to manage children, and children older than two years of age must wear a face mask during the entire visit and maintain social distancing practices.
3. Visitation must be scheduled in advance with Harrison House of Chester County and visits will not exceed 45 minutes per visit.
 - a. Additional time will not be permitted if the visitor arrives outside of their assigned time.
 - b. Visits can be scheduled by telephone (610-384-6310) to the front desk Monday through Friday between 9am to 4pm.
4. During the 45-minute visit, the visitors must remain the same. There will be no switching visitors during visitation.
5. All visitors must sign-in and out at the designated Check-In station and be assessed for symptoms prior to visit and complete an Informed Consent for Outdoor Visitor form. If a visitor does not pass the screening they will not be permitted to visit.
 - a. Refusal to participate in the screening process or refusal to adhere to social

distancing and universal masking requirements will result in the visitor being prohibited to visit.

6. Visitation is limited to residents unexposed to COVID-19.
7. Visitors will not be permitted during mealtimes.
8. Universal masking, hand sanitation, and social distancing must be practiced during the entire visit for both residents and visitors.
9. To accommodate every resident in the community, residents will be limited to one visitation per week at this time.
10. Hours of visitation will be:
 - a. Monday – 1 pm until 7pm (last visit at 6pm – no visits 12-1 or 5-6)
 - b. Tuesday – No visits.
 - c. Wednesday – 1 pm until 7pm (last visit at 6pm)
 - d. Thursday – No visits.
 - e. Friday – 10 am until 5 pm (last visit at 4pm – no visits 12-1)
 - f. Saturday – 9 am to 3pm (last visit at 2pm – no visits 12-1)
 - g. Sunday – 9 am to 3pm (last visit at 2pm – no visits 12-1)
11. All visitors must be screened for fever, symptoms or known exposure prior to visiting and must complete the questionnaire. Screening practices are subject to change upon recommendations of the CDC, Health Department and Bureau of Human Services.
